
The main functions of the TWG are:

- a) to assist in ascertaining and defining the environmental problems, land use patterns and economic objectives in the area vis a vis the existing environmental laws, rules and regulations;


- b) to assist the consultants commissioned for this study (Radian Canada Inc) in the conduct of the field surveys, in gathering relevant data and in setting up meetings with appropriate government offices/officials and the private sector;
- c) to provide technical direction to the consultants especially in the development of an environmental protection and pollution control guidelines;
- d) to evaluate the consultant's report and submit recommendations to the Steering Committee of the MEIP.

The committee is authorized to conduct meetings and consult with concerned government agencies and officials to effectively carry out its functions.
