SUBJECT:

Authorizing the Conduct of Orientation Conference and Workshop on the Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee Program in Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), Baguio City on March 14-16, 1995

In the interest of the service and in order to implement the Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee (MFPC) sub-component of the Forest Protection and Law Enforcement Component of the ADB funded Forestry Sector Project (Loan II) being undertaken by the National Forestation Development Office (NFDO), the staging of an orientation conference and workshop on the process of implementing and organizing the MFPC in CAR is hereby authorized. The orientation conference and workshop shall be held at the Mountain Lodge and Restaurant, Leonard Wood Road, Baguio City on March 14-16, 1995.

The participants to this orientation conference and workshop shall be composed of the RED, RTDs, PENROS, CENROS, RFDO Coordinator of CAR and invited representatives of selected government organizations, other government agencies, non-government organizations, and religious and civic organizations as listed in Attachment 1 hereof, and made part of this Order.

The funding requirements for the conference and workshop shall be provided by National Forestation Development Office. Travelling expenses of Region CAR based participants shall be charged against Loan II CAR funds and the Manila based participants, support staff and secretariat shall be charged against NFDO Loan II funds, subject to existing auditing rules and regulations.

The National MFPC Coordinating Group under the Special Concerns Office shall provide the technical assistance and administrative support in all aspects of preparations and conduct of this conference and workshop to ensure proper orientation of prospective CAR Regional MFPC. Expenses attendant to the assistance and support activities of NMFPC-CG shall be provided by NFDO.

The CAR office shall provide all required equipment, office fixture and implements in the preparations and conduct of the conference and workshop including transportation facilities that may be required by the support staff and secretariat.

The ENR-SECAL shall make available the assistance and support of its MFPC Consultants by making available their expertise and experience in organizing and mobilizing MFPCs in ENR-SECAL MEC regions.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
