SUBJECT:

Creating a Special Task Force to investigate/validate complaints and purported violations of the of the Hopewell Power Philippines Corporation relative to its Pagbilao Coal-Fired Thermal Power Plant at So. Guidding, Polo, Pagbilao Grande, Quezon

In the interest of service and in order to investigate the violations of the Hopewell Power Philippines Corporation in regards to the 700MW Pagbilao Coal Fired-Thermal Power Plant located at So. Guidding, Pagbilao Grande, Quezon, a Special Task Force is hereby created. It shall be composed of the following:

5.	Mr. Dan August C. Gozar Environmental Management Bureau	<u>-</u>	Member
6.	Representative DENR Region IV	-	Member

The Task Force shall coordinate with the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Officer (PENRO) and the Multi-sectoral Monitoring Team (MMT) and jointly



undertake a final evaluation and validation of the complaints and violations and come up with a final report of its findings and recommendation to the Secretary.

All expenses to be incurred shall be chargeable against the Environmental Monitoring Fund set up for the said project.

This Order shall take effect on 22 October 1997 and remain enforced until the submission of the final report and recommendation by the Task Force.
