**SUBJECT: Authorizing the conduct of the Social Reform Agenda Third Quarterly Flagship-Sectoral Forum on October 28-31, 1997.**

1. In the interest of service and pursuant to the processes called for under the Social Reform Agenda, the Fourth SRA Quarterly Flagship Forum shall be conducted on October 28-31, 1997 at the Danarra Hotel, Mother Ignacia Street, Quezon City.
