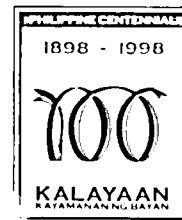

SUBJECT: Organizing the Executive Committee and Technical Working Group for the Development and Implementation of the DENR Forest Management Information System (FMIS).

In line with the efforts to improve the forest management information system of the Department for effective and efficient planning and decision making and in furtherance to DENR S.O. The Technical Working Group is tasked to perform the following:


1. Determine the information requirements of all stakeholders regarding the three (3) key forestry components: community-based forestry; industrial forestry and protected area forestry.
2. Assess the existing Information Systems vis-a-vis the identified information requirements;
3. Develop and implement prototype information systems that would address data gaps;
4. Recommend ways to institutionalize data sharing between FMB and DENR.

In the discharge of the assigned tasks, the TWG is authorized to call or seek assistance from any official or employee of the Department whenever necessary.

The personnel herein designated shall, in addition to their duties and responsibilities attached to their present positions and assignments, perform the duties and functions as may be required in consonance with this Order.

The Head of CBFMO is likewise authorized to source funds from the different CBFM and POF programs/ project to support the TWG.

This Order shall take effect immediately and supersede all previous issuances inconsistent herewith.
