Moreover, they must attend and actively participate in the Seminar-Workshop on the Identification of Important Biodiversity Areas in Addition to the Existing Protected Areas on 23 April 1997. They must bring the following documents for the purpose:

- Regional Development Plan including maps;
- Provincial maps showing park boundaries, zoning and vegetation;



- 3. List of proposed and existing protected areas (including maps);
- information on the resource inventory of provinces within the region to include agricultural, mining, forestry, etc.; and,
- 5. other relevant information including maps pertaining to the workshop topic.

The Chief, PAWD shall represent the RTD EMPAS in case the latter could not attend the forum.

Transportation of the participants shall be shouldered by their respective offices subject to the existing auditing rules and regulations. Their food, lodging and kit shall be shouldered by the organizers.
