**SUBJECT: Authorizing the conduct of a Social Reform Agenda
Quarterly Flagship-Sectoral Forum on June 3-7, 1997.**

1. In the interest of service and pursuant to the processes called for under the Social Reform Agenda, a Quarterly Flagship-Sectoral Forum shall be conducted on June 3-7, 1997 at the Danarra Hotel, Mother Ignacia Street, Quezon City.
