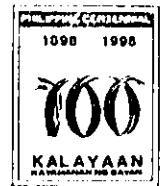



The participation of excess representatives from the Regional Offices shall be borne by the respective Regions while the travelling expenses of resource persons from the PAWB and PRCP participants shall be shouldered by PAWB out of the PRCP funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
