Marciano A. Macatangay Jr.


In addition to their present work assignment, the above personnel shall :

- secure the assistance of other sectors such as LGU's, other government agencies in promoting the sustainability of the subprojects;
- assess the work performance of the FSP Regional Monitoring Officer and recommend appropriate measures to meet the targets of the Region.
- attend other needs of their respective areas with regards to the subproject implementation.
