SUBJECT: REASSIGNMENT OF ENGR. ANTONIA CRISANTA CORINTHIA N. NAZ FROM THE MINES AND GEOSCIENCES BUREAU TO THE OFFICE OF THE UNDERSECRETARY, FOR ENVIRONMENT AND PROGRAMS DEVELOPMENT

In view of the urgent need of the Environment and Programs Development Office for a technical staff who is skilled in policy analysis, environmental and resources economics, cost-benefit analysis, community resource management and other fields concerning environmental issues such as trade liberalization, Engr. Antonia Crisanta Corinthia N. Naz, Supervising Science Research Specialist, Ecosystems Research and Development Service, Region I, is hereby reassigned from the Mines and Geosciences Bureau to the Office of the Undersecretary for Environment and Programs Development.

Engr. Naz shall clear herself of work, property and financial accountabilities in her present assignment and shall report to the Undersecretary for EPD. She shall provide assistance in initiating and evaluating policies on environment and natural resources, in reviewing environment and natural resources-related issues presented by the Bureau under EPD, in evaluating mines-related ECC applications, and other tasks as may be assigned by the Undersecretary for EPD.

This Order is effective upon the issuance of the Commission on Election of an exemption from COMELEC Resolution No. 2946 dated 16 September 1997 and is good until March 30, 1998.
