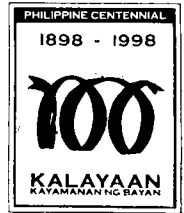

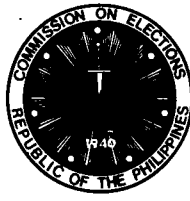

This Order shall take effect upon the issuance of the Commission on Election of an exemption to COMELEC Resolution No. 2946 dated 16 September 1997.

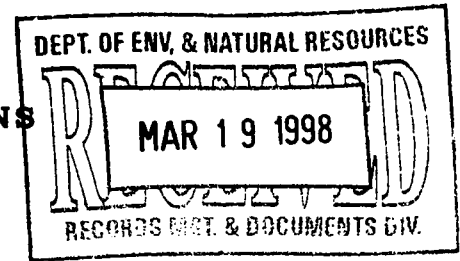
