The above-mentioned staff shall:

1. Report to the RTD for Forestry for coordination and related concerns.
2. Facilitate the implementation of the remaining backlogs identified during the annual planning workshop.
3. Assist and/or facilitate transfer of project activities to the local government units and in the preparation of the sustainability plan.
4. Assist in the implementation of CBFMO strategic action plan.
5. Prepare and submit a detailed monthly action plan and accomplishment report approved by the DBFMO Regional Officer and noted by the RTD Forestry and/or by the Regional Executive Director.
6. Report back to the ENR-SECAL PMO on June 20, 1998.

These personnel shall be allowed to claim per diems and traveling expenses while in their respective areas of assignment within the regions, chargeable against ENR-SECAL funds subject to availability thereof and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Likewise, these personnel shall clear themselves of their present responsibilities from ENR-SECAL Program Office.

This Order shall take effect upon approval by the COMELEC pursuant to Section 261 (IV-1) of the Omnibus Election Code (B.P. Bldg. 881).
