ENR-SECAL PROGRAM ORIENTATION AND WORKSHOP ON THE PREPARATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION COMPLETION REPORT (ICR) February 02-03, 1999 Grotto Vista, Bulacan

Rationale:

In anticipation of the ENR-SECAL Program closing date in December 1999, top management see the need for an intensive preparation of the program's Implementation Completion Report (ICR) in accordance with World Bank evaluation requirements. To ensure comprehensiveness in the program review and quality in the performance evaluation, a series of workshops and consultation meetings will be conducted by the PMO of the ENR-SECAL Program from January to September 1999. The first of the series will be an orientation on the ICR processes for all component teams involved in the preparation of the report.

Objectives:

- 1. To be able to orient the ICR teams on the Bank's methods and procedures for evaluating developmental projects.
- 2. To prepare the evaluation design and appropriate instruments for the various focused-areas and components of ENR-SECAL.
- 3. To draw-up the teams terms of reference, action plans and milestones.

- 3. Terms of Reference, Team Action Plan, Timetable and Outputs/Milestones

Methodology:

The orientation will be conducted by the members of the Advanced Workshop on Evaluation System (AWES) Team through lecture and group exercise.

Action Planning for the conduct of evaluation and preparation of the ICR will be done through small group session by each team under the guidance of the Integrators.
