The technical working group shall provide technical and secretariat support to the DENR La Niña Task Force and perform such function as maybe delegated by the Chairman.

To ensure smooth operation and in times of calamity or emergency, the task force may engage the services of selected Field Operations personnel, Special Concern Office (SCO), Presidential Task Force on Water Resource Development and Management (PTFWRDM), and concerned Regional/Provincial/Community Environment and Natural Resources Office personnel.

Personnel assisting the Task Force may be authorized to render overtime services subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Traveling allowances, per diems and other allowable expenses incurred for the operation of the task force shall be chargeable against the La Niña funds.

All orders, memoranda, circulars inconsistent with this order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

This Order takes effect immediately.
