Subject: Authorizing the Attendance of DENR Personnel in the Regional Orientation Seminar-Workshops on the Revised DENR Statistical Reporting Forms and Forum on the Devolved Forest Management Functions

In the interest of the service and in line with the PEENRA institutionalization process as per Executive Order No. 406, the following DENR Personnel are authorized to attend the Regional Orientation Seminar-Workshops on the revised DENR Statistical Reporting Forms to be held during the First and Second Quarters of 1999 in four venues, namely: San Fernando, La Union; Tuguegarao, Cagayan; Iloilo City and Tacloban City.

Participants shall be representatives from Regions 1, 2, CAR, 5, 6, 7 and 8 composed of Regional Sectoral Statistical Coordinating Units (FMS, LMS, EMPAS, ERDS and MGB) as well as a representative each from FMS, LMS, and EMPAS from the CENROs who are directly involved in the preparation of the statistical forms. Representatives from the Planning and Policy Studies Office (PPSO), Sectoral Bureaus and Attached Agencies and the PEENRA Management Unit shall act as resource speakers. Research and Statistics Division (RSD) of the PPSO and the respective Regional Planning and Management Division and Human Resource Development staff members shall act as the secretariat (See Attachment A”).


Their attendance shall be on official time. Food and accommodation of the participants and resource speakers at the venue shall be chargeable against PEENRA funds. Transportation expenses of resource speakers shall be charged against the Bureaus PEENRA funds (LAA) and the RSD representatives shall be charged against OSEC PEENRA funds while transportation expenses of participants and regional secretariat shall be chargeable against their respective offices. All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Representatives from the Local Government Units (LGUs) and the private sector shall also be invited to participate in the orientation of the Mines and Geosciences Bureau forms. They shall, however, be required to pay for their food and accommodation. The PPSO and Forest Management Bureau representatives shall also discuss with the LGUs the provisions of Joint Memorandum Circular No. 98-01 on the devolved forest management functions.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force for the duration of the above-mentioned seminar-workshop.
