DENR SPECIAL ORDER

SUBJECT

Creation of a Fact-Finding Committee to investigate and gather facts and documents on the alleged various anomalous acts committed by Mr. Linog M. indol, OIC-Regional Executive Director, DENR-Region

In the interest of the service and in order to determine the veracity of the alleged various anomalous act of RED Linog M. Indol, DENR-Region XII, as contained in the letter of the DENR Employees Association which was referred to this Office by the Ombudsman for Mindanao dated December 10, 1999, a Committee is hereby created to investigate the said anomalous acts, to be composed of the following:

- 1. Atty. Jimmy Pesigan
- 2. Atty. Alfredo Nava
- 3. Atty. Guido Taoingan

The Committee is hereby authorized to issue subpoena <u>duces tecum</u> and subpoena <u>ad testificandum</u>, to compel attendance of parties and their witnesses and the production of documents.

The Committee may avail of the services of personnel of the DENR and its field offices or those of the bureaus under it for the accomplishment of its assigned tasks.

All expenses incurred in pursuance of this activity shall be charged against OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The Committee shall submit its report within fifteen (15) days from the termination of the investigation.

This Order takes effect immediately.
