SUBJECT : AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF A PLANNING WORKSHOP TO OPERATIONALIZE THE NEW ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE AT THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY – FIELD OPERATIONS OFFICE AND TO STUDY THE PROPOSED AUGMENTATION BUDGET FOR THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE AGRARIAN REFORM PROGRAM (CARP) AND THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES MODERNIZATION ACT (AFMA) FROM JUNE 23 TO 25, 1999, TAAL VISTA HOTEL IN TAGAYTAY CITY.

In the interest of the service and to effectively implement the integrated ecosystems management concept at the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and to study the proposed augmentation budget in support to the attainment of the objectives of the Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Program (CARP) and the Agriculture and Fisheries Modernization Act (AFMA) and other joint undertakings of DENR with other national and international institutions, a planning workshop is hereby authorized.

A. Objectives

1. To strengthen the internal policies, operational procedures and organizational structure to effectively and efficiently achieve the mandates of the Office of the Secretary, Special Concerns Office and Field Operations Office per DENR Administrative Order No. 99-18 and DENR Special Order No. 99-619.
2. To review the proposed budget of DENR for CY 2000 as against the activities it is mandated to implement; and
3. To review DENR commitments to AFMA, CARP, PTFWRDM and other national and international institutions and determine the corresponding budgetary requirements for CY 2000.

B. Target Outputs

1. Guidelines detailing the roles, responsibilities and functions of various Offices directly under the direct supervision of the Secretary, DENR.

2. Work and Financial Plan for CY 2000 indicating the activities and proposed budget needed to support the development of Economic Development Zones and other mandates given to the DENR to achieve the objectives of the AFMA; and
3. Work and Financial Plan for CY 2000 indicating the activities and proposed budget needed to support the development of CBFM-Agrarian Reform Communities (CBFM-ARC) within forest zones.
