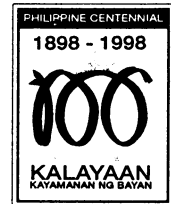

SUBJECT : CREATION OF AN AD-HOC COMMITTEE TO REVIEW, DISCUSS AND NEGOTIATE FOR THE DENR APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATION (DOTC) AND DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE (DOF) ON THE EFFECTIVE MONITORING OF NATURAL RESOURCES COMMODITIES, CHEMICAL SUBSTANCES AND HAZARDOUS WASTES.

In the interest of the service and in order to effectively monitor the entry and exit of the different forest products, flora and fauna including its derivatives, chemical substances and hazardous wastes and mineral and mines products including its derivatives which are collectively termed as Natural Resources Commodities and Hazardous Wastes, an ad-hoc Committee within DENR is hereby created to compose of the following:

The Bureau Directors and different DENR Offices herein identified as member shall designate and submit the name of its representative to the Chair one (1) week upon receipt of this Order.

The Committee shall review, discuss and negotiate the passage of the proposed MOA with the **DOTC** particularly within the concerned functions of Philippine Ports Authority (PPA), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) and Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA); and with the Department of Finance (**DOF**) particularly within the concerned functions of Bureau of Customs (BOC), Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) and Economic Intelligence and Investigation Bureau (EIIB).

The **Forest Economic Division (FED)** of the FMB shall act/perform as the Secretariat to provide technical and administrative support to the Committee.

This **Order** shall take effect immediately.
