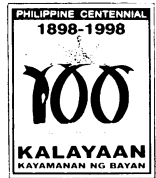

**SPECIAL ORDER**

**SUBJECT : RECONSTITUTING THE DENR COMMITTEE  
TO EVALUATE PROTESTS ON APPOINTMENTS**

In the interests of the service and in accordance with Section F of the DENR Merit Promotion Plan (MPP) and System of Ranking Positions, the DENR Committee on Protests on Appointments is hereby reconstituted and shall be composed of the following :

The Committee shall be an advisory body which shall assist the Secretary and the resolution of protested appointment/promotion filed by any officer or employee. Specifically, its functions shall be:

1. Receive, process and recommend action on protest against appointment or promotion in the Department Proper, Bureaus and Regional Offices in accordance with Civil Service laws and regulations and pertinent policies promulgated by the Department;
2. Act cases within thirty (30) days from receipt of the protests; and

3. Submit in writing to the Secretary its findings and recommendations including a draft of decision for signature/ of approval and/or disapproval.

The Personnel Division shall serve as a Secretariat of the Committee.

If the protestant is not satisfied with the decision of the Department, he/she may elevate the case to the Civil Service Commission Merit System Protection Board in accordance with Sec. 21 (6), Chapter 5 of Book V of Executive Order No. 292 and its Omnibus Rules.

This Order takes effect immediately and revokes all previous Orders inconsistent herewith.
