**SUBJECT : CREATING COMPOSITE FOREST INVENTORY TEAMS
TO GATHER RELEVANT INFORMATION NEEDED IN
THE REVISION AND PREPARATION OF A
COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT AND MANAGEMENT
PLAN (CDMP) OF IFMA NO. 010 ISSUED TO
NORCAMCO.**

1. In the interest of the service and pursuant to DENR Administrative Order No. 97-04 and in order to obtain updated and relevant information for the revision/preparation of the CDMP of IFMA No. 010; Composite Forest Inventory Teams are hereby created which are composed of the following:

2. The aforesaid Composite Forest Teams shall perform the following:
 - 2.1 Coordinate with LGUs, NGOs and concerned stakeholders before actual forest inventory is undertaken;
 - 2.2 Conduct 10% forest inventory of all blocks under IFMA No. 010 to gather but not limited to the following informations;

- a) Extent and location of openland, brushlands, degraded residual forest, adequately stocked residual forest and established forest plantations;
- b) Area and location of active kaingins/cultivation including the owners thereof and number of dependents;
- c) Location of cultural communities and area occupied (if any) within the area of IFMA No. 010 and approved potential IFMA sites, including the number of those Indigenous People;
- d) Take photographs of the natural and plantation forests within the subject areas; and
- e) Prepare/submit comprehensive report under oath to the Secretary thru the FMB Director within fifteen (15) days upon completion of the field works.


2.3 The teams are authorized to seek the assistance of any DENR Officials/personnel of Region XI to facilitate the early completion of the inventory.

2.4. The teams are allowed to claim per diems and reasonable transportation expenses chargeable against the trust fund deposit of the holders of IFMA No. 010, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing regulations.

3. This Order shall take effect immediately.
