CREATION OF A TEAM TO CONDUCT AN END OF PROJECT IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF THE ENR-SECAL PROGRAM

In the interest of the service and pursuant to DENR Administrative Order No. 99-16, an End-of-Project Impact Assessment of the ENR-SECAL Program-Regional Resources Management Component will be conducted within the 1st semester of this year. The objectives of the assessment are the following: a) to determine the effects and impacts brought about by project interventions; b) to determine comparative conditions between "with project" and "without project" conditions; c) to assess impact sustainability and relevance to over-all program goals and objectives; and d) to identify and synthesize lessons learned, project successes and milestones based on project experience.

The Team shall proceed to the field and conduct a briefing on the purpose of the Assessment and the general procedures of the activity. The Project and the concerned Regions shall provide the Team with counterpart personnel, transportation, accommodation and all necessary support to facilitate the assessment.

Results of the assessment shall be discussed and presented to the Project and to the designated Review Panel at FASPO after the completion of the report. All expenses to be incurred in connection with the assignment shall be charged against the ENR-SECAL, NRMP, FASPO and OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The specific schedule of the assessment will be tentative to consider the progress of work in each of the site to be covered.
