- Formulate and come up with appropriate strategies in the preparation of the negotiations of the proposed site and the packaging of a feasibility study of the proposed operation of Materials Recovery and Composting Facility (MRCF) located at the above-cited area;
- 2. To look into a management scheme by which NRDC and other investors would be able to venture into the concept of sustainable ecolo gical waste management;
- 3. Lay-out a strategies by which the out of school youths and students shall be involved and employed in the proposed MRCF Project; and
- 4. Shall meet periodically to discuss policy strategies on sustainable waste management upon approval of this order.

The team is authorized to seek the assistance of concerned government agencies and instrumentalities in the carrying-out of the assigned task and shall submit a report with complete documentation to the UNDERSIGNED on updates of the periodic meeting including its recommendation.

All expenses to be incurred shall be chargeable to the NRDC funds subject however to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
