CREATION OF A PROJECT STUDY TEAM FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ABANDONED MINING PIT OF ATLAS MINING, INC. INTO A SANITARY LANDFILL.

In the interest of the service and in order to facilitate the establishment of a sanitary landfill site to service the areas of Cebu and its immediate vicinity, a Project Study Team is hereby created to undertake the initial evaluation to determine the suitability of the abandoned open mining pit of Atlas Mining, Inc. in Toledo City for development into a sanitary landfill. The Project Study Team shall have the authority to invite or consult other people within or outside of the DENR as resource persons and cause any or all of its members or other DENR personnel or units to conduct field visits and investigations and allow any of its members to attend seminars and other educational trainings related to their work or function.

The members of the Project Study Team shall meet as they deem necessary and all expenses incurred by the members in the pursuit of their work related to the project shall be charged against the funds of their respective offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

The Team shall, after a period of three (3) months from the approval of this Order, submit a final report for the study, which shall contain the technical and economic feasibility of the project including pricing policies and cost of development among others.

To facilitate, allow the smooth performance and insure the success of the work of the Project Study Team, all employees of the DENR are hereby enjoined to extend their full support and cooperation to the project.
