In the interest of the service and to facilitate the smooth implementation of Kaliwa Watershed Development and Management Project, a multisectoral Council is hereby created to be known as Kaliwa Watershed Management Council and to be composed of the following:



The Council shall provide guidance and serve as advisory group to the Kaliwa Watershed Development and Management Project under the auspices of the Water Resources Development Project – Watershed Management Improvement Component (WRDP-WMIC) and may decide on major issues relative to project implementation.

The Council shall meet at least once in every three months or as the need arises as may be determined by any of its members and affirmed by the Chairman.

All expenses to be incurred by the Council in carrying out its functions shall be charged against the WRDP-WMIC depending on the availability of funds and subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
