The workshop aims to achieve two objectives: first, is to provide shelter assistance to 50% the estimated 2,000-2,500 of evacuees whose houses were totally damaged or an estimated 1,141 families during the period August-December 2000; second, is to provide community members in these resettlement areas with the basic services and livelihood assistance.

The workshop also intends to identify areas where convergence of services of agencies involved in relief and rehabilitation of municipalities affected by the conflict in Central Mindanao will be operational.

As such, the above named participants are expected to bring during the workshop the pertinent documents/information (e.g. workplan, ongoing projects located in the affected municipalities of Central Mindanao, etc.) that could help in the identification of areas where DENR can cooperate its services with LGUs and other agencies.

Expenses to be incurred relative to the attendance of the above-named officials/staff to the said workshop shall be chargeable against their respective offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect for the entire duration of the said workshop.
