

The Special Team shall review and evaluate the application for the renewal of OLP Lease Agreement No. 12 (Amd. 1) of Colorado Shipyard Corporation and undertake appraisal on the value of the land and all existing improvements within the area to be used as basis for the updated annual rental of the subject area. They shall coordinate with the concerned DENR Field Officials and Local Government Units for assistance in carrying out their mandated tasks and shall submit a report to the undersigned five (5) days upon completion of their fieldwork.

Traveling and other expenses incurred in the discharge of their functions shall be chargeable against available funds of their respective offices, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations
