Each region is required to bring the following equipment: 1) Total Station with accessories; 2) GPS units; 3) at least one pair of hand-held radios; and 4) transit which shall be used during the practicum.


Traveling expenses of participants, resource persons and training staff to and from their official stations shall be charged to their respective offices.

Each participant shall pay a registration fee of TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) chargeable against the Banner Program Funds in their respective regions to be used for training supplies and materials required during the practicum. The registration fee shall be remitted and payable to the DENR Regional Executive Director- CAR.

Food and accommodation, honoraria of resource persons and other training-related incidental expenses shall be charged against the HRMS, Central Office Funds.

All allowable expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
