They shall be entitled to actual/matriculation fees, stipends, book allowance and other allowable expenses under DENR Administrative Order No. 2000-77, otherwise known as "Revising Certain Provisions of DENR Administrative Order No. 96-15." These expenses shall be charged against the funds of the Human Resource Management Service (HRMS) subject to their availability and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The above-named employees shall clear themselves of all accountabilities from their present work assignments and shall sign a Local Scholarship and Service Obligation Contract within thirty (30) days after enrollment for their first semester. The contract shall serve as the basis for evaluation of performance as regards compliance with scholarship rules and regulations.

This Order is in effect for the duration of the scholarship grant only as stipulated in their Local Scholarship and Service Obligation Contracts.
