DESIGNATION OF ENGR. ALEXANDER O. OLIVAR AS THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE LARGE SCALE MINING SECTOR TO THE PROVINCIAL MINING REGULATORY BOARD OF RIZAL

In response to the Resolution of the Montalban Aggregates Producers Association nominating Engr. Alexander O. Olivar as their official representative to the Provincial Mining Regulatory Board (PMRB) of Rizal vice Mr. Edwine Jesuitas and in accordance with the pertinent provisions of R.A. No. 7942, otherwise known as the Philippine Mining Act of 1995 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations as embodied under DENR Administrative Order No. 96-40, ENGR. ALEXANDER O. OLIVAR is hereby designated as the new Representative of the Large Scale Mining Sector to the PMRB of the Province of Rizal for Rodriguez (Montalban) and San Mateo areas.

In the performance of this duties and functions, Engr. Olivar shall be guided by the provisions of R.A. No. 7076, otherwise known as the "People's Small Scale Mining Act of 1991;" Section 17 (B) (iii) and 138 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991; R.A. No. 7942, otherwise known as the "Philippine Mining Act of 1995" and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations; P.D. 1899 (Establishing Small Scale Mining Act as New Dimension in Mineral Development); DENR Administrative Order Nos. 30, 34 and 37, Series of 1992; DENR Memorandum Circular No. 10, Series of 1992; Malacañang Memorandum Circular No. 30 dated 09 February 1991 "Prescribing Guidelines for the Implementation of 1991 Local Code (R.A. No. 7160); and other laws, rules and regulations governing the administration and disposition of mineral resources.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless revoked in writing by the undersigned or any other competent authority.
