The Technical Committee in coordination with FASPO shall oversee the activities of the DENR-CLASP launching program. A booth/tent for the exhibit of different livelihood products from DENR-Regions I, II, and IV-B shall be set-up. Likewise, the DENR-NCR shall be in-charge of the design and preparation of exhibits from the participating regions and collecting photos/materials from FMB, FASPO and ERDB for display.

Awarding of checks /seed money for the DENR-CLASP selected beneficiaries from Regions 1, II, IV-A, IV-B, VI, VII, X and NCR will be one of the highlights of the program.

All expenses of officials and personnel to be incurred shall be chargeable to their respective offices. However, expenses of exhibitors for transporting the livelihood products and other incidental expenses related to this activity shall be chargeable to FASPO Special Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order is for strict compliance and takes effect immediately.
