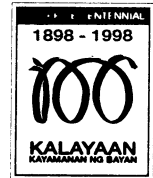

Subject : **Authorizing the Participation of the Presidential Task Force on Water Resources Development and Management (PTFWRDM) and Some DENR Personnel in the Conduct of Regional Consultation-Public Hearing on the Proposed "Clean Water Act".**
