Participants of the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM) shall pay a seminar fee of *Four Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty Five Pesos* (P4,785.00) each to cover the following: food, accommodation for four (4) days, supplies and materials and honorarium of the resource persons. Travelling expenses of all the participants, resource persons, nursery assistants and members of training staff are chargeable against their respective offices. Except for the participants of ARMM, whose expenses shall be charged against the Trust Fund, the accommodation, food, training supplies and other training related expenses are chargeable against the HRMS funds. All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

A training report shall be submitted by the HRMS to the undersigned, fifteen (15) days upon completion of the training program.
