CREATION OF COMPOSITE TEAM FOR THE
CONDUCT OF PHYSICAL INVENTORY OF
PROPERTIES OF THE CONSERVATION OF PRIORITY
PROTECTED AREAS PROJECT (CPPAP)

PCU and/or Site Representative, CPPAP

The Team to be assisted by a representative from the DENR-COA field Office of the site, shall prepare and submit report for each site and consolidated report to the Office of the Secretary (OSEC) thru PAWB upon the completion of all inventory works of the Project on or before June 2002.

All expenses to be incurred during the conduct of the inventory and validation shall be chargeable against the CPPAP funds subject to the existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and supersedes all previous issuances inconsistent hereof.
