INVENTORY SUBJECT: CREATING A COMPOSITE **FOREST** INVENTORY CONDUCT TEAM TO VALIDATION RESIDUAL FOREST AND VALIDATE THE 100% INVENTORY OF NATURALLY GROWING TREES INTERSPERSED WITHIN THE PLANTATIONS OF BENSON REALTY DEVELOPMENT CORP. AND SAN ROQUE SAWMILL CORP. UNDER IFMA NOS. R4-006 AND R4-004, RESPECTIVELY, BOTH LOCATED IN SAN LUIS, AURORA

1. In the interest of the service and pursuant to DAO No. 99-53, an inventory and validation team is hereby created to determine the degraded residual and production residual natural forests areas, obtain an updated and relevant information on the subject IFMA areas, validate the 100% inventory of naturally growing trees interspersed within the established plantations, and install the Log Control Monitoring System (now Forest Stocks Monitoring System). The Team shall be composed of the following:

- 2. The Team members are allowed to claim per diems and reasonable transportation allowances chargeable against the trust fund to be deposited by the IFMA holders to the Forest Management Bureau subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 3. The Teams shall submit comprehensive report under oath to the Secretary thru the FMB Director within fifteen (15) days upon completion of the field work; and

4. This Order shall take effect immediately.
