The PSC shall provide guidance and oversee the implementation of the Metro Manila Solid Waste Management Project. It shall meet at least once every quarter.

The Technical Working Group, on the other hand, shall review and evaluate the accomplishments and reporting obligations of the consulting firm (i.e. inception report, interim project report, draft final report, final report and monthly progress reports). It shall likewise undertake the review and evaluation of proposals for the establishment of community-based solid waste management facilities under Component A of the Project. The group shall submit their evaluation and recommendations to the Project Steering Committee for approval.

All expenses to be incurred shall be chargeable against the project funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The order shall take effect immediately and shall be automatically revoked upon the completion of the project.
