**SUBJECT: CREATION OF THE DENR PRIVATE SECTOR
COOPERATION AND INVESTMENT PROGRAM
NETWORK**

In the interest of the service and to promote more effective DENR-private sector cooperation and ecologically sound and sustainable private sector (business and industry and civil society) investments in ENR development and management, the DENR Private Sector Cooperation and Investment Program Network is hereby created to support the implementation of the Private Sector Cooperation and Investment Program of the Department.

The Network shall be composed of focal points, two (one main and one alternate) from each DENR office and bureau. They shall be designated by the concerned office or bureau head. The initial lead focal points are hereby designated as follows:

The required list of lead focal points, as well as alternate focal points, shall be completed by all concerned offices and bureaus on or before February 8, 2002. FASPO shall coordinate the finalization of the list for the reference of all concerned.

Let's Go Green!

The focal points shall perform the following functions:

1. Facilitate DENR action of their offices/bureaus on matters affecting ENR private investments;
2. Provide Support to the Private Sector Cooperation and Investment Program in building an appropriate investor-friendly Management Information/Communication System (MI/CS);
3. Provide information on status of investment-related matters within their offices;
4. Help promote positive and cooperative relationship between the DENR and the private sector (business and industry and civil society); and
5. Help identify ENR development and management opportunities, programs, projects and activities within their scope of work, that the private sector may invest or participate in.

The Network shall coordinate closely with the relevant offices/bureaus of the DENR, particularly the Private Sector Cooperation and Investment Program Support Group of OSEC/FASPO, which relate directly to the private sector.

All expenses that shall be incurred by the focal points in the exercise of their functions shall be charged to the funds of their respective offices.

This Order takes effect immediately.
