SUBJECT : AUTHORIZING A MULTI-SECTORAL REVIEW OF REGIONAL MEMORANDUM ORDER (RMO) NO. 2002-014 TO BE HELD ON FEBRUARY 27, 2003 IN DENR CARAGA, REGION 13, AMBAGO, BUTUAN CITY

In the interest of the service and in view of the issues raised by some sectors in Region 13, there is a need to have a multi-sectoral review of the RMO No. 2002-014 in order to assure its effectiveness and its implementability consistent with the existing forestry laws, rules and regulations. A Team is hereby created composed of the following:


The Team shall have the following functions:

1. Collate and review all issues and concerns regarding the implementation of RMO No. 2002-014.
2. Review the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed by and between the DENR and PWPA in relation with existing forestry laws, rules and regulations.
3. Make the necessary amendments, if warranted, based on the results of the consultation with the concerned parties.
4. Submit the result of the review ten (10) days after its conduct.

The Office of the Regional Executive Director (ORED) shall act as the Secretariat of the Team and shall coordinate with and invite the representatives from the concerned LGUs, Philippine Wood Producers Association (PWPA), PICOP, CARAGA Federation of Tree Farmers and Developments, Inc.

(CFTFDI), National Government Agencies, Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) and other tree farmers association in the Region.

All expenses relative to the conduct of the review and the travelling expenses to be incurred by the members of the Team shall be charged against the budget of the DENR CARAGA Region and to their respective offices concerned, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
