DENR SPECIAL ORDER No. 2003 - 172

SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF THE ORIENTATION ON

THE IMPLEMENTATION OF "ADOPT-A-MOUNTAIN

PROGRAM" (AMP)

In support to the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by Secretary Heherson T. Alvarez and Bishop Julio Xavier Labayen, President, Community Action and Respect for our Environment (CARE) on September 2002, the conduct of the above-mentioned activity is hereby authorized.
