CREATION OF REGIONAL CRISES REACTION TEAMS (RCRTs) TO ACT ON CRITICAL ISSUES IN

THE FIELD

In the interest of the service and in order to address the various issues on Environment and Natural R esources (ENR) management that have recently surfaced in the field, or about to surface, the Regional Crises Reaction Team is hereby created to undertake the following functions:

- 1. Classify the issue as to its stage of development as follows:
 - Emerging It may evolve into a demand on ENR management. It is a topic of public speculation / discussion
 - Existing It is currently influencing ENR management. It involves public emotions and clamor for action.
 - Top Priority It is a demand on ENR management. It has attained media exposure or reached the Office of the President.
- 2. Institute mechanisms / actions to neutralize these ENR issues, until such time that solutions are found to address them;
- 3. Exert best efforts to contain / resolve such issues at the regional level; and
- 4. Submit fastest means to this Office every Friday, or as the need arises, a report (see attached format) of actions taken and/or recommended top level action.

The Regional Crises Reaction Team as created shall be composed of the Regional Executive Director as Chairman and the Regional Directors of MGB and EMB as members. It shall be under the direct supervision and control of the Undersecretary for Field Operations.

Inaction or complacency in the face of such issues may be ground for appropriate administrative sanctions against the Regional official concerned.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
