All workshop related costs and traveling expenses of the Central Office participants shall be charged against OSEC allocation under the Agrarian Reform Fund (ARF). registration fee shall be charged for the regional participants. However, their traveling expenses shall be charged against their respective regional allocation under ARF and DAR-ADB-ARCP budget (for those regions involved in DAR-ADB-ARCP), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
