(PMRB)**


In view of Memorandum Order No. 132, Series of 2003 issued by Quezon Governor Wilfrido L. Enverga appointing Atty. Diego Q. Francia as Alternate Representative of Ms. Evelyn Sio-Abeja (PMRB Member/LGU Representative) and in due consideration of PMRB Resolution No. 0109, Series of 2003 adopted and approved by the Board on 23 May 2003 requesting the Provincial Governor to appoint an alternate representative of Ms. Evelyn Abeja to the PMRB which were forwarded to this office by the PMRB Secretariat as per endorsement letter dated 06 August 2003, and in accordance with the pertinent provisions of R. A. 7942, otherwise known as the Philippine Mining Act of 1995, and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations as embodied under DENR Administrative Order No. 96-40, ATTY. DIEGO Q. FRANCIA is hereby designated as Alternate LGU Representative to the Quezon PMRB.

In the performance of his duties and functions, Atty. Francia shall be guided by the provisions of R. A. 7076, otherwise known as the "People's Small-Scale Mining Act of 1991;" Section 17 (B) (iii) and 138 of R. A. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991;" R. A. 7942, otherwise known as the "Philippine Mining Act of 1995" and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations; P. D. 1899 (Establishing Small Scale Mining Act as New Dimension in Mineral Development); DENR Administrative Order Nos. 30, 34 and 37, Series of 1992; DENR Memorandum Circular No. 10, Series of 1992; Malacañang Memorandum Circular No. 30 dated 09 February 1991 "Prescribing Guidelines for the Implementation of 1991 Local Code (R. A. 7160);" and other laws, rules and regulations governing the administration and disposition of mineral resources.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless revoked in writing by the undersigned or any other competent authority.
