**SUBJECT : CONDUCT OF AND ATTENDANCE TO THE PUBLIC
CONSULTATION ON THE GUIDELINES FOR THE RATING OF
FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PHILIPPINE CLEAN AIR
ACT OF 1999.**
