SUBJECT: DEPUTATION AS ENVIRONMENTAL AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICERS (DENROs) OF TEN (10) OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF DAGULOS LUMAD OF MARAMAG (DALUMA) ASSOCIATION IN DAGULOS, LA ROXAS, MARAMAG, BUKIDNON.

Pursuant to the provisions of DENR Administrative Order No. 41, Series of 1991 and Section 9, Page 67 of DAO No. 11 dated February 8, 2000, the following officers and members of the Dagulos Lumad of Maramag (DALUMA) Association are hereby appointed as Deputy Environment and Natural Resources Officers (DENROs) within the vicinities of Mt. Kiamukon, to wit:

They shall exercise the power and authority provided for in the aforesaid administrative orders, laws, rules and regulations under the supervision of the Community Environment and Natural Resources Officer concerned.


By virtue of this deputation, they are authorized to detect/investigate violations of environment and natural resources laws, rules and regulations and to arrest without warrant any person who has committed, is committing or is about to commit in his/her presence any of the offenses defined in Chapter IV of Presidential Decree No. 705 as amended and other pertinent laws within their territorial jurisdiction.

They are also authorized to apprehend the tools and equipment and conveyances used in the commission of the offense and the natural resources products extracted/cut, gathered, removed and possessed by the offender/s in the process of committing the offense. In all instances of detection, arrest and/or apprehension, they shall deliver within the period prescribed by law from time of arrest and apprehension, the offender/s and apprehended natural resources products, tools and equipment including the conveyance/s used to the seizure officer of the DENR.

They are further authorized to administer oath and take acknowledgement in official matters connected with their aforementioned functions and to take testimonies in official investigation/s conducted under the authority of the aforecited laws as amended and its implementing rules and regulations.

They shall submit to the concerned Regional Executive Director of the DENR through the PENRO/CENRO concerned to undergo the required orientation briefing on basic environment and natural resources laws, rules and regulations relative to his functions as Deputy ENRO before officially discharging their duties and responsibilities.

This Order takes effect immediately and will expire on October 31, 2004 or unless sooner revoked or terminated by this office.
