SUBJECT : **CREATION OF A TECHNICAL COMMITTEE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF WHITE SMOKE STANDARDS FOR TRICYCLES AND MOTORCYCLES**

Pursuant to Section 1, Rule XXXIII of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2000-81 – Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 8749 – The Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999, the DENR through the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB), in coordination with the Department of Transportation/Land Transportation Office (DOTC/LTO), shall review the standards every two (2) years or as the need arises and shall revise the exhaust emission standards for new and in-use motor vehicles when necessary, to achieve substantial improvement in air quality for the health, safety and welfare of the general public.

To assist the DENR review the existing tricycle and motorcycle emission standards and to establish new standards, a Technical Committee is hereby created to be composed of the following:

The Committee shall perform the following functions:

1. Establish white smoke standards for tricycles and motorcycles consistent with the provision of RA 8749 and DAO 2000-81; and



2. Formulate operational procedures in the implementation of the white smoke standards for tricycles and motorcycles.

The Committee shall take into consideration the possibility of harmonizing national standards with international standards.

The attendance of the Committee members to meetings and other activities shall be on official time and all related expenses incurred by them shall be charged against the budget of their respective agencies/institutions.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain valid until the white smoke standards for tricycles and motorcycles have been established.
