Reporting and Entitlement of Personnel Detailed to the Land Administration and Management Project (LAMP) (including Amendment of Special Order No. 2002-1017 dated November 29, 2002 and Special Order No. 2001-44)

In the interest of the service, Special Order No. 2002-1017 dated November 29, 2002 is hereby amended due to the replacement by the Land Registration Authority, a co-implementer of LAMP, of the Prototype Manager for LRA-managed LAMP Prototype Implementation Office 2 (PIO 2). Moreover, consistent with the agreement of the LAMP Inter-Agency Coordinating Committee (now the LAMP Task Force) to utilize existing staff of key implementing agencies and in aid of strengthening the LAMP Project Management Office (PMO), Special Order No. 2001-44 dated January 22, 2001 is hereby amended to change the Monitoring and Evaluation Unit Chief.
