DENR SPECIAL ORDER
NO. 2004 - 212

SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF ORIENTATION WORKSHOP FOR PROVINCIAL ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICERS (PENROS) REGIONAL AND PROVINCIAL IP DESK OFFICERS ON THE HARMONIZATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INDIGENOUS PEOPLES RIGHTS ACT (RA 8371) AND ENR LAWS AND POLICIES.

Workshop expenses including accommodations, supplies and materials in the amount of P412,500.00 shall be chargeable against the following DENR offices:


