COORDINATING TEAM WITHIN THE DENR**



- 1.0 The functions and responsibilities of the LAM Reform Team are as follows:
- 1.1 Coordinate advocacy and IEC activities;
 - 1.2 Initiate and facilitate preparation of an integrated/synchronized plan for mainstreaming LAM concerns and proposed reform measures into the regular work plans of the relevant offices/units;
 - 1.3 Initiate review of reform measures that may have the potential of conflicting/contradicting with existing laws, rules and regulations;
 - 1.4 Identify policy issues and gaps and operational problems that may hamper the adoption and/or implementation of the LAM reform measures;
 - 1.5 Based on the review, recommend steps to be taken to resolve the conflict/contradiction;

- 1.6 Serve as focal persons in respective units/offices for all LAM-related concerns;
 - 1.7 Perform other functions/tasks as may be assigned by the Executive Committee.
- 2.0 In order to enable the Team to perform their functions efficiently and effectively, they shall be provided with the proper briefing and orientation in the LAMP and the proposed reform agenda.
 - 3.0 All offices/units are also directed to give the required support and assistance to the Team.
 - 4.0 The members of the Team shall be entitled to reasonable expenses other applicable benefits in the performance of their functions, chargeable against LAMP funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall be in force unless revoked/amended/revised in writing by the undersigned or higher authorities.
