

The Team shall have the following functions:

1. Coordinate with the Office of the RED, LGUs and other concerned government offices.
2. Conduct investigation on the alleged large-scale logging in the Northwest Panay Peninsula a protected area declared under the NIPAS Law.
3. Submit a Completed Staff Work report on the matter with fifteen (15) days after the completion of the assigned tasks as bases of whatever actions this office may deem appropriate.

The Team is authorized to collect allowable traveling expenses, per diems and other incidental expenses in the performance of their tasks, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations, chargeable against their respective offices.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
