

The validation and assessment shall cover activities of Development Alternatives, Inc. (DAI) and Tetra Tech EM Inc., Technical Assistance Teams for EcoGov Project and CRMP, respectively, on forest/forestland management (FFM), coastal resource management (CRM) and integrated solid waste management, when applicable, starting in Region 9 (Western Mindanao) in mid- to late July 2004. A final report on the field validation and assessment shall be prepared and submitted to the Office of the Secretary not later than 15 days after the completion of the field work.

The Teams shall coordinate with the concerned DENR offices, regional DAI and Tetra Tech staff, local executives, NGOs, NGAs/OGAs, and other local project implementing partners.

All expenses incidental to the conduct of the field validation and assessment shall be charged against EcoGov Program funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until the completion of the activity.
