SUBJECT : DEPUTATION AS ENVIRONMENTAL AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICERS (DENROs) OF ELEVEN (11) MEMBERS OF THE KABINSA TRIBAL FARMERS AND FISHERFOLKS ASSOCIATION (KATRIFFA) AND SIX (6) MEMBERS OF SAMAHANG KATUTUBO NG LUPANG NINUNO (SKLN) IN BARANGAYS DIBUT AND DITEKI, SAN LUIS, AURORA

Pursuant to the provisions of DENR Administrative Order No. 41, Series of 1991 and consistent with the Joint DENR-NCIP Memorandum Circular No. 2003-01 dated October 31, 2003, the following members of the Kabinsa Tribal Farmers and Fisherfolks Association (KATRIFFA) and (SKLN) are hereby appointed as Deputy Environment and Natural Resources Officers (DENROs) within the vicinities of San Luis, Aurora, to wit:

They shall exercise the power and authority provided for in the aforesaid administrative orders, laws, rules and regulations under the supervision of the Community Environment and Natural Resources Officer concerned.


By virtue of this deputation, they are authorized to detect/investigate violations of environment and natural resources laws, rules and regulations, and in the absence of an authorized DENR personnel, to arrest without warrant any person who has committed, or is committing in his/her presence any of the offenses defined in Chapter IV of Presidential Decree 705 as amended and other pertinent laws within their territorial jurisdiction.

They are also authorized to apprehend the tools and equipment and conveyances used in the commission of the offense and the natural resources products extracted/cut, gathered, removed and possessed or taken by the offender/s in the process of committing the offense. In all instances of detection, arrest and/or seizure, they shall deliver within the period prescribed by law from time of arrest and seizure, the offender/s and seized natural resources products, tools and equipment including the conveyance/s used to, and file proper complaint with the appropriate official designated by law to conduct preliminary investigation and file information in court through the CENRO or PENRO or RED, whoever is expediently available.

They are further authorized to administer oath and take acknowledgement in official matters connected with their aforementioned functions and to take testimonies in official investigation/s conducted under the authority of the aforementioned laws as amended and its implementing rules and regulations.

They shall submit to the concerned Regional Executive Director of the DENR through the PENRO/CENRO concerned to undergo the required orientation briefing on basic environment and natural resources laws, rules and regulations relative to his functions as Deputy ENRO before officially discharging their duties and responsibilities.

This Order takes effect immediately and will expire one year after the approval of this Order or unless sooner revoked or terminated by this office.
